Ready Mix Inc. Announces Opening of New Las Vegas Plant

The new plant is located approximately fifteen miles north of city limits off of US 95 at Lee Canyon Road. The new Lee Canyon facility will include a sand and gravel production operation in the near future, as well as a ready-mix concrete batch plant.

"This new plant location improves Ready Mix, Inc.'s delivery capabilities to Northwest Las Vegas, and the future on-site sand and gravel production will eliminate the need to truck raw materials to this location," said Robert R. Morris, President.

This new plant is RMI's third plant in Las Vegas and fourth in Clark County. Most of the new ready-mix trucks to be based at Lee Canyon have already been delivered, with 10 more due in September, which will raise the Company's total fleet size to 184 trucks.

RMI currently operates two ready-mix concrete plants in the metropolitan Phoenix area, three plants in the metropolitan Las Vegas area, and one plant in Moapa, Nevada. The Company also operates two sand and gravel crushing and screening facilities in Clark County, Nevada and one in northwest Arizona, which provides raw materials for its Las Vegas and Moapa concrete plants as well as decorative rock. In Phoenix and Las Vegas, RMI deploys a fleet of 174 mixer trucks to deliver its ready-mix concrete to customer job sites.
